



Resolution 51: Amendments to Slope Day Programming Board's Appendix B Guidelines

Abstract: This resolution seeks to amend Slope Day Programming Board's Appendix B Guidelines to reflect updates on Slope Day Programming Board's mission and artist selection announcement

Whereas, Appendix B of the Student Assembly Charter outlines the guidelines that byline funded organizations must adhere to in order to receive funding;

Whereas, for each byline funding cycle, the Appropriations Committee has regularly updated Appendix B to reflect the recommendations of the Appropriations Committee and the Assembly;

Whereas, there was an attempt to update funding guidelines outlined in Appendix B in the Fall of 2021 but the resolution was tabled indefinitely;

Whereas, Slope Day Programming Board plans to announce the artist selection for Slope Day 2022 in a manner that differs from what is outlined in the current version of Appendix B;

Whereas, Slope Day Programming Board has an updated mission statement and focus and would like to see these changes reflected on their Appendix B guidelines

Be it further resolved, lines 811- 824 under "Section 4: Organization Specific Guidelines" of the Student Assembly Charter's Appendix B will be amended to read as follows:

Q. Slope Day Programming Board (SDPB)

i. The Slope Day Programming Board (SDPB) will work with the Cornell community to plan and promote a Slope Day (occurring on the day after the last day of classes in the spring) centered on the Cornell community and its celebration of the past year, working to break down social barriers, building a greater sense of tradition and community, and fostering an environment where students, staff, and faculty can come

32 together as one Cornell. The Board shall promote a day that fosters a safe and
33 healthy environment with multiple social and recreational options.

34 ii. The allocation for the SDPB shall be used exclusively for programming and
35 publicity for an event at the end of the spring semester.

36 iii. The SDPB shall organize a non-alcoholic Slope Fest event concurrent to
37 Slope Day.

38 iv. SDPB shall offer all undergraduate students free admission to Slope Day,
39 unless expressly permitted by the SA

40 v. The Slope Day Programming Board shall collect demographic information
41 from all Slope Day entrants. These statistics shall be reported to the SA and
42 GPSA the Fall semester following Slope Day

43 ~~vi. The Slope Day Programming Board shall announce artist selection first at a~~
44 ~~Student Assembly meeting~~

45 vii. The Slope Day Programming Board shall set a price floor for non-activity fee
46 paying individuals approximately equal to the total activity fee disbursement
47 divided by projected undergraduate attendance. The price paid by non-activity fee
48 paying individuals shall be no less than the activity fee,

49 **Be it finally resolved**, the Student Assembly amend Slope Day Programming Board's Appendix
50 B of the Student Assembly Charter to reflect Slope Day Programming Board's updated mission
51 and artist selection announcement more accurately
