

## Resolution 18: Calling on the Cornell University Administration to Publicly Support the Gayogohó:no' (Cayuga Nation) Council of Chiefs and Clan Mothers Demands

- 5 Abstract: This resolution calls for the Cornell University Administration to release a statement
- 6 voicing support for the Gayogohó:no' (Cayuga Nation) Council of Chiefs and Clan Mothers
- demands, urging the Bureau of Indian Affairs to remove Clint Halftown as the Gayogohó:no,
- 8 Cayuga Nations' federal representative, establishing support for the Cayuga Nation Council of
- 9 Chiefs and Clan Mothers as the legitimate government, and urging President Biden to meet with
- 10 Council of Chiefs and Clan Mothers.

- Whereas, the Two Row Wampum (a treaty initially established between the Haudenosaunee
- 18 Confederacy and Dutch Settlers in 1613, and later extended to the fledgling United States)
- 19 commits to noninterference in one another's governance affairs while proceeding in relationships
- of peace and friendship, and
- Whereas, in accordance with the Two Row Wampum, the Gayogohó:no' have put forth various
- requests for help, including within the May 15 letter from the Council of Chiefs and Clan
- 23 Mothers, for those withing the United States to be holding the U.S. government accountable on
- 24 this issue.

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- Whereas, due to his repeated acts of harassment and violence towards the Gayogohó:no', the
- 26 Cayuga Nation Council of Chiefs and Clan Mothers—the traditional leadership of the
- 27 Gayogohó:no'— does not recognize Clint Halftown as their federal representative.



- 28 Whereas, on February 22, 2020, in the early morning hours, Clint Halftown ordered the
- destruction of the traditional Gayogohó:no' schoolhouse, several homes, and businesses, leading 29
- to violence against the Gayogohó:no' and their allies.<sup>1</sup> 30
- Whereas, on May 15, 2021, the Gayogohó:no' (Cayuga Nation) Council of Chiefs and Clan 31
- Mothers released a letter addressing the abuses their people have faced from the orders of Clint 32
- Halftown.<sup>2</sup> 33
- Whereas, "in the middle of a global pandemic Clint Halftown has issued eviction notices and 34
- court dates to the traditional Cayuga citizens. The Cayuga Nation citizens, Chiefs and Clan 35
- Mothers consider the court established by Halftown as illegitimate." <sup>3</sup> 36
- Whereas, the Gayogohó:no' "are experiencing daily harassment by [an] illegitimate non-Cayuga 37
- 38 Police force." 3
- 39 Whereas, Clint Halftown "continues to bring harm, anxiety, and stress to the traditional Cayuga
- 40 citizens in an already stressful year." 3
- 41 Whereas, the Cayuga Nation Council of Chiefs and Clan Mothers "do not support Clint
- 42 Halftown his government or his actions and [request he] cease and desist from using the
- collective rights of the Cayuga Nation." 3 43
- 44 Whereas, as cited by the Cayuga Nation Chiefs and Clan Mothers, Article VII of the 1794
- Canandaigua Treaty states "... complaint shall be made by the party injured, to the other: by the 45
- Six Nations or any of them, to the President of the United States." 3 46
- 47 Be it therefore resolved, the Student Assembly is in support of the Cayuga Nation Council of
- Chiefs and Clan Mothers' statement, subsequent demands, and is convinced of the merits of their 48
- 49 case.
- 50 **Be it therefore resolved,** the Student Assembly demands the Cornell University Administration
- make a formal statement urging the Bureau of Indian Affairs to immediately remove Clint 51
- 52 Halftown's designation as the 'federal representative' of the Gayogohó:no', in accordance with
- 53 the calls in the Council of Chiefs and Clans Mothers' letter.
- **Be it further resolved,** the Student Assembly demands the Cornell University Administration 54
- formally voice support for the Council of Chiefs and Clan Mothers as the rightful governing 55
- 56 body of the Gayogohó:no' with which all levels of the U.S. government should be engaging in a
- Nation-to-Nation relationship.<sup>3</sup> 57

- 61 1794 Treaty of Canandaigua.<sup>4</sup>
