2	Ensuring Applicant Accessibility to SAFC Guidelines
3	
4	ABSTRACT: This resolution amends the SAFC Charter to help lower-tier organizations receive
5	funding by incentivizing their attendance at a "Help Session."

9	Whereas, the Student Assembly is charged with effectively voicing the concerns of the
10	undergraduate student body; and
11	
12	Whereas, the Student Assembly is tasked with overseeing the Student Activities Funding
13 14	Commission (SAFC) and approving amendments to the Charter thereof, from time to time,
15	as the public interest requires it; and
16	Whereas, it is in the interest of the undergraduate student body to ensure that as many register
17	organizations as possible are able to secure funding from the SAFC; and
18	
19	Whereas, ensuring accessibility for all undergraduate students is a priority of the 2017-2018 Student
20	Assembly; and
21	
22	Whereas, having a member of SAFC-funded organization attend a "Help Session" offered by the
23	Student Activities Funding Commission reduces the chance that lower-tiered organization
24	will make a technical mistake and not receive funding; then

26 27	Be it therefore resolved , the Student Assembly amends the Bylaws of the SAFC to include the following amendment in Appendix A: Funding Guidelines:
28	Tollowing amendment in Appendix A. Funding Guidennes.
29	2.1.2. Help Sessions
30	All organizations that are, at the time of their application, assigned Tier 4, Tier 5, Tier 6, or
31	New Group (Tier 7) must demonstrate that the Treasurer, President, or Advisor attended at
32	least one of the help sessions at a pre-announced date. If the Treasurer, President, or
	Advisor is unable to attend any of the help sessions, they may designate another member of
33	
34	the organization to attend a help session on their behalf.
35	
36	Organizations that do not meet the above requirement forfeit their right to demand a SAFC
37	Appeals Board Hearing, but may be granted such a hearing at the discretion of the Chair of
38	the SAFC Appeals Board for truly exceptional circumstances. The affected organization will
39	still retain the right to a budget hearing.

41	Be it further resolved, the Student Assembly amends the Bylaws of the SAFC to include the
42	following amendment in Appendix A: Funding Guidelines under #4 by adding:



43	and it has fulfilled the "Help Session" requirement as outlined in section 2.1.2.

45	Be it finally resolved, The Student Assembly strongly recommends that the Treasurer, President,
46	Advisor, or a chosen designee of each SAFC-applicant attend a SAFC "Help Session" to
47	reduce the probability that the organization they represent loses funding and that the quality
48	of campus life is diminished; and
