



Resolution 34: Proposed Charter Amendment for the 2022-2024 Byline Funding Cycle

Abstract: This resolution amends the SA Charter Appendix A provision for the final recommendation of the Student Activity Fee deadline to be extended.

Whereas, the Student Assembly Charter provision stated in Appendix A §4, item C.viii (lines 452-453) state “The committee will submit its final recommendation, including individual allocations, to the Assembly in the form of legislation at least two weeks before the end of the semester”;

Whereas, the Byline funding process was delayed due to unforeseen circumstances, including the resignation of the Vice President of Finance and the cancelation of byline hearing meetings due to quorum not being reached;

Whereas, an interim Vice President of Finance was appointed at the regular meeting of the SA on October 21, 2021;

Whereas, the new Vice President of Finance was elected at the regular meeting of the SA on November 11, 2021;

Whereas, the interim, and subsequently elected, Vice President of Finance continued the byline funding process that was well underway; however, they had to cancel byline report meetings due to not reaching quorum;

Be it therefore resolved, the deadline established in lines 452-453 of Appendix A, “The committee will submit its final recommendation, including individual allocations, to the Assembly in the form of legislation at least two weeks before the end of the fall semester” be amended to read:

“The committee will submit its final recommendation, including individual allocations, to the Assembly in the form of legislation no later than the **final meeting of the SA** in the Fall semester.”
